BACKGROUND

Legal Action Worldwide (LAW) is a unique non-profit organization, which provides creative legal assistance in conflict affected states. LAW has established an international and domestic accountability program in Bangladesh to support Rohingya refugees. LAW is working with the Rohingya women's survivor group known as Shanti Mohila to increase their access to justice and resilience to sexual and gender-based violence through community-based protection capacity building.

Job Summary

Legal Action Worldwide is looking for an education consultant to assist in developing materials appropriate for our women's empowerment and leadership programme. LAW works with a Rohingya women's civil society group known as Shanti Mohila. The members of the group are illiterate and have requested basic literacy and education so they can operate as an organisation. At present no education activities are available for women in the Rohingya camp in Cox's Bazar. The consultant will support these efforts so literacy skills can be integrated into LAW's activities with the women.

Responsibilities

- Suggest appropriate teaching and learning materials for beginner level English language learners in Shanti Mohila education program with LAW (length: 2-3 month "course") including Cox's Bazar Education Sector materials developed by British Council
 - Including: key vocabulary (sight words) and competencies/learning objectives based on four language teaching domains (reading, writing, listening and speaking)
- Develop/share capacity building plan/suggestions for English teacher(s) in Shanti Mohila language program with LAW
- Develop/share classroom observation tool (for both teacher self-reflection and external observations)
- Develop/share sample lesson planning tool
- Develop simple guidance on English language teaching for instructor
- Share suggested methods of daily/weekly assessments based on teaching and learning materials
- Share list of suitable Ed. tech ideas (sample apps and online programs)



- Share list of suitable open source materials

Qualifications/Skills

- Teaching qualification from a reputable university
- 5+ years experience working on education in humanitarian context
- Experience working on adult education
- Strong understanding of challenges for adult women accessing education
- Strong understanding of education standards and policies in the Rohingya crisis
